



## MATERNAL FETAL MEDICINE ELECTIVE

**Prerequisites:** Clerkship in OB/GYN

### Description

This elective is designed for the fourth-year medical student who is interested in pursuing a career in obstetrics and gynecology. This rotation provides an intense experience in antepartum diagnosis of maternal and fetal conditions in high risk pregnancies, including exposure to prenatal ultrasound diagnostic and evaluation techniques. Much of the teaching is one-on-one with Dr. Ali.

Experience will be gained at:

- California Maternal Fetal Medicine, located at Folsom, CA.
- Labor and delivery at Mercy San Juan Medical Center located at Carmichael, CA. (optional)

Prenatal diagnosis, Ultrasonography, Genetic counseling, Chorionic Villous Sampling, and Amniocentesis techniques are emphasized. The student works directly with Dr. Ali.

### Objectives of the Elective

The student will understand the principles of prenatal diagnosis and care of high-risk pregnancies.

### Key Responsibilities of the student while on Elective

- Attendance at all consultations by Dr. Ali, at California Maternal Fetal Medicine.
- Attendance at daily morning rounds with Dr. Ali, at Mercy San Juan Medical center labor and delivery. (optional)
- Attendance at the weekly Diabetes and Pregnancy Program (DAPP) chart review, held weekly on Thursdays at Mercy San Juan Medical Center. (optional)
- Keep a log of all patients seen in the rotation.

### Method of Evaluation

Dr. Ali evaluates the student. No exam is given, but the overall evaluation is based on clinical performance. Evaluation forms are provided by, and submitted to, the medical school directly.

### Scheduling Information

Months Offered: All year

First day report to: California Maternal Fetal Medicine at 1645 Creekside Drive, Folsom, CA 95630 (email Diana Allen prior to start date to determine a time), then prearranged meeting with Dr. Ali – email at least 2 weeks prior to start date.
